Protocol when a Patient with Bed Bugs Leaves the Facility

- The Enviro Steam is an effective and simple solution to ensure the facility is protected from bed bug infestation after a patient completes their treatment.
- Utilizing the Enviro Case for the personal belongings in conjunction with the Enviro Steam after the patient leaves the facility ensures the safety of the staff along with prevention of infestation.

Procedure:

- Use the Enviro Case to kill bed bugs on the patient's personal belonging while undergoing treatment.
- Use the Enviro Steam on the arms, legs of chairs, couches, furniture, cushions, anywhere the bed bug can crawl off of the patient when treatment is completed.
- Enviro Steam procedure takes 4 minutes and will ensure facility and staff are safe from bed bug infestation. The Enviro Steam kills bed bugs on contact.

Protocol for Using the Enviro Steam:

- Add 175ml of water to the Enviro Steam
- Plug the Enviro Steam into an electrical outlet for 2 minutes
- When the patient has left the treatment chair, using the custom flexible attachment, aim the nozzle toward the bed bug and then press the button to release the steam
- Bed bugs are killed on contact
- To ensure eradication, use the Enviro Steam on the arms and legs of the chair where the patient was receiving treatment
- Use the Enviro Steam in the cushions of the chair where bed bugs can hide
- Unplug the Enviro Steam when completed with use
- PLEASE NOTE: The cap will NOT twist off until the unit is completely cooled

It is important to follow these simple procedures.

Keeping bed bugs out of the facilities is vitally important to the health and safety of your patients and coworkers.
